My Raby Deer is called.....

Did you know....?

- A male Red deer is called a Stag, a female red deer is a Hind, and baby red deer are Calves.
- A male Fallow deer is called a Buck, a female fallow deer is a Doe, and baby fallow deer are Fawns.
- It's easy to tell our Red and Fallow deer apart fallow deer are smaller, and some have spots on their coats. Our herd of Fallow deer vary in colour from white through to black. see how many different deer you can spot when you visit the park at Raby Castle.
- Only stags and bucks have antlers, which start growing in the spring and are shed each year, usually at the end of winter.
