### Did you know....?

- A male Red deer is called a Stag, a female red deer is a Hind, and baby red deer are Calves.
- A male Fallow deer is called a Buck, a female fallow deer is a Doe, and baby fallow deer are Fawns.
- It's easy to tell our Red and Fallow deer apart - fallow deer are smaller, and some have spots on their coats. Our herd of Fallow deer vary in colour from white through to black. – see how many different deer you can spot when you visit the park at Raby Castle.
- Only stags and bucks have antlers, which start growing in the spring and are shed each year, usually at the end of winter.
